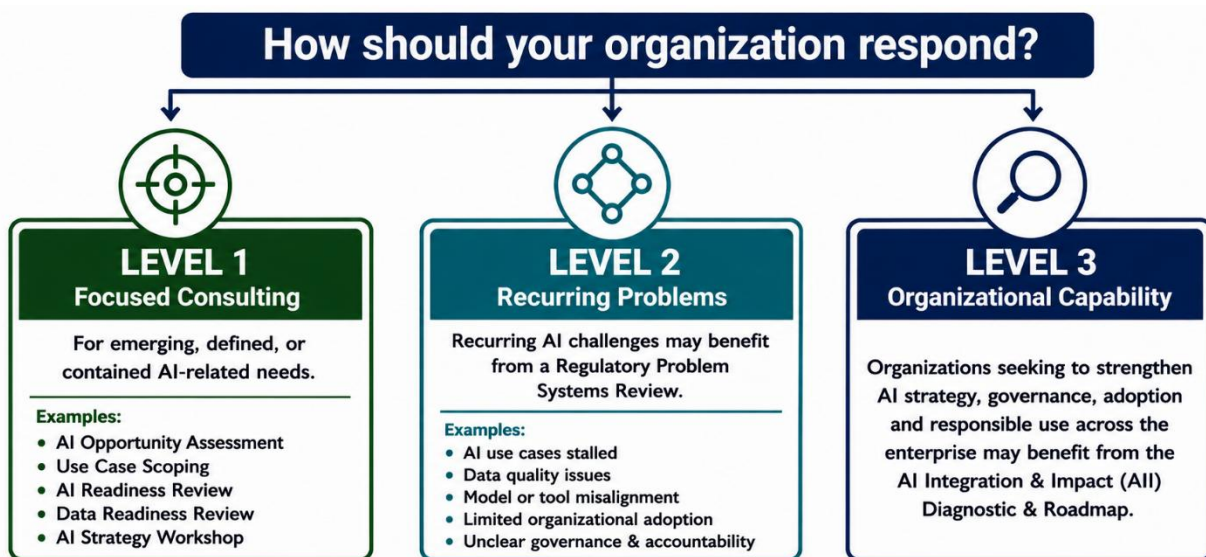
Artificial intelligence (AI) is moving rapidly into operational use across the regulatory sector. - How should AI be governed?
- What risks require oversight?

Many organizations are experimenting with AI. Far fewer have established the governance, safeguards, workforce capability, oversight mechanisms, and organizational systems needed to support responsible AI adoption.

- AI tools are being explored or adopted without an enterprise governance approach.
- Governance expectations have not kept pace with implementation.
- Leaders want clearer accountability and oversight arrangements.
- Privacy, fairness, transparency, or public-interest concerns are emerging.
- Staff require guidance, training, or support regarding AI use.
- Boards and senior leaders are seeking informed discussions about AI opportunities and risks.
- AI initiatives are occurring as part of broader modernization or digital transformation efforts.
